Learning Objectives

The Think Tank Leadership and Management Training is based upon a competency framework specifically designed to **enhance critical leadership skills** in the "business of expertise", tailored to the think tank (or "applied research") environment.

During the program, you will apply practical management approaches and reflect on sectoral shifts as well as your leadership responsibilities.

After completing the program, you will be able to:

- Understand sectoral change and its implications for the business of expertise and the role of think tanks;
- Develop and position impactful research strategies in a changing market of ideas;
- Design and manage effective research projects in a think tank environment;
- Define and advance your role within and beyond your organization;
- Shape organizational development bottom up, top-down and across teams;
- Catalyze team success through effective guidance, feedback, supervision and mentorship.

Participants

The training program is open to professionals from think tanks and policy-oriented research institutions with a team leadership position based in Germany. Participants should have research project management as at least one of their responsibilities.

- Foster a culture of innovation, collaborative problem-solving, and continuous improvement;

Tuition Fee

Participation in the Leadership and Management Training is possible for a fee of EUR 790,00 (excl. statutory VAT).

The tuition fee covers all expert lectures, learning materials, lunch and coffee breaks, as well as access to the Think Tank Lab community and alumni networks. The fee <u>does not</u> include travel and accommodation. Participants are responsible for arranging and covering these costs themselves.

- A CV indicating your professional experience in think tanks/research institutions.

The participants of the 2025 cohort will be announced no later than May 20, 2025.

Selection Process

Participants will be selected on the basis of their experience and expertise, their challenges, and on how the program will support them at this point in their career. The Think Tank Lab team will take into consideration the background of other participants to ensure a diverse cohort.
